

# MIGRATION PROCESS

## for incoming students

If you come to Colombia to carry out academic activities as a student, there are two options to enter the country:

### 1. Entry and Stay Permit (PIP)

- Verify that your nationality does not require a visa to enter Colombia.
- Make sure you have a valid passport to enter the country.
- Upon entry, indicate that the purpose of your visit is academic.
- Present the letter addressed to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs that the University sent you.
- Present your acceptance letter from the University.
- Make sure that the stamp in your passport says PID (Permiso de Ingreso y Permanencia / Entry and Stay Permit) and not PT (Permiso de Turismo / Tourism Permit).
- Verify that the PID is valid for 90 days.
- If you plan to stay longer than 90 days, request the Temporary Stay Permit (PTP) at Migración Colombia.
- Enviar copia de la renovación del permiso a la Oficina de Relaciones Internacionales e Interinstitucionales (ORII) de tu universidad.

### 2. Visitor Visa or Visa Type "V"

- Verify whether your stay will be longer than 180 days or if your nationality requires a visa to enter.
- If necessary, request a Visitor Visa (Type V).
- If you plan to stay more than 90 days with a visa, you must request your Foreigner ID Card (Cédula de Extranjería).
- If your stay is less than 90 days, you do not need to request the ID Card.
- If you are already in Colombia with a PID and wish to stay more than 180 days, you must apply online for your Student Visa.
- Keep your migration status updated and renewed.
- Send a copy of the renewals of your migration status to the International Relations and Interinstitutional Office (ORII).
